This list of mammals and birds includes all species recorded for Victoria, including those that are no longer present in the State and extinct species which formerly occurred in Victoria. Some birds that are rarely recorded visitors to Victoria are not listed. Alien species which have established feral populations are indicated by an asterisk (*). You may wish to use the list to compile a checklist of species observed on your property.

The definitions used for conservation status categories are those of the International Union for the Conservation of Nature (IUCN) as listed below. "Taxa" means species or sub-species (including those still undescribed).

(X)	Extinct	taxa not definitely located in the

(E) Endangered: taxa in danger of extinction in

Victoria and whose survival is unlikely if the causal factors

continue.

(V) Vulnerable: taxa believed likely to move into

the 'Endangered' category in the near future if the causal factors

continue operating.

(R) Rare: taxa with small Victorian

populations that are not at present 'Endangered' or 'Vulnerable', but

are at risk.

(I) Insufficiently taxa in Victoria that are *suspected* known but not definitely known to be

'Endangered', 'Vulnerable' or 'Rare', because of lack of

information

(C) Restricted taxa at risk because they have colonial only a few colonial breeding or breeding or roosting sites (even though the
